The PTA has some very good news to share with all pupils and parents. At the end of last term we submitted a bid to the **Big Lottery Fund** and we have now received a conditional offer of **£9,998**.

The name of the project is **“Reading you loud and clear”** and the purpose is to provide opportunities for pupils to improve their life skills in reading and communication and to enhance their social and cultural development.

To achieve these aims, the plan is to use the grant to fund the following:

- **New shelves for the library**
- **New books for the library**
- **A range of after school clubs including:**

Drama club

Dance club

Gardening club

Chess club

Reading club

Poetry workshop

The first poetry workshop will take place on **Friday 21st Oct** which the whole school will have the opportunity to take part in. The remaining clubs will commence after half term – with further details to follow stating dates, times and age groups for the different clubs. The intention is to charge a nominal fee for the after school activities to reduce the costs for next year if it is decided that the activities continue.
