Head Teacher's Hello:

At school this week, on Wednesday, we were privileged to have an old pupil come to visit, Mrs Jean Haughton (nee Clifton) who was a pupil at Glazebury in 1938! She brought a photograph into school of her class and explained that at this time it was the last photograph of any classes until after the second world war. Mrs Haughton could name all the class and had many a story to tell about the area. She remembered the Head Teacher, Mr Dennett, who we know started at Glazebury in 1935. We have a photograph in school that has a teacher sat with a class with the name Mrs Tootal on the back, Mrs Haughton confirmed that she was her class teacher and this puts our own photograph in that period. We showed Mrs Haughton around the old part of our school and she was impressed by our toilets as in her time the toilets weren't flushable and had to be cleaned out once a month! We have recorded all that Mrs Haughton said to start our own history trail, we have taken some pictures around the plaque and it was lovely to surround Mrs Haughton with a pupil from every year group, including our youngest pupil. If any of your parents or grandparents came to Glazebury and have photos to share it would be wonderful to see them.
