'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1910-October 27th- Sergeant Major Wright, Drill Inspector visited the school and inspected all the classes in drill.

1910-November 24th- Blackboards renovated by the London Blackboard Company cost 19/-

1910-February 8th – Douglas Wright played truant all day, this is the 3rd offence of this boy since Christmas, and it is now time for drastic measures. I have reported this and pointed out its seriousness.

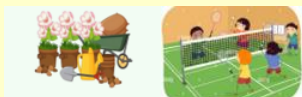

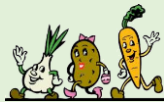
