'Peep into Glazebury's History from Log Books - We are in possession of our school log books that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.



1881 May 12th -School attendance officer visited the school today. The average for the week is 160, being the highest the school has yet obtained. The number on the books is 205.

1881 Sept 4th- The Diocesan inspectors inspected the children's religious knowledge.

1881-Oct 20th -There have been 84 children absent on account of measles.

1881- Oct 28th- Mary Ann Gill has been absent for 3 days on account of illness.







Attendance Celebration – Year groups who achieve 100% in a week receive 2 tickets, and year groups with above 97% receive one ticket. On a weekly basis tickets are recorded and totalled at the end of the half term as a whole year group.


