Dear Parents and Carers

Glazebury's School Council and Ethos Committee are proud to present details of our fundraising event for **Macmillan cancer support**. We know that cancer can have a devastating impact on people's lives and we want to help.

We would like to invite you to join our staff and children at our Coffee and Cake afternoon which will take place at school between 2pm and 3pm on Friday 26th September in the school hall.

Donations of cakes will be gratefully received - please can we ask that donations of cakes be brought into school on the Friday morning - either home made or shop bought.

Please remember we are a nut free school so please do not bring in any cakes or biscuits that contain nuts.

As well as cakes to purchase on the day, we will be running two competitions: 1) Guess the weight of the cake for adults and 2) Guess how many smarties are on the cake for children. There will also be a silent auction for staff-made cakes! Our fantastic PTA will be supporting and serving drinks on the afternoon to support this event.

Classes will be brought into the event throughout the hour, so the children can select and purchase their own cakes.

Class 1: 2.45pm to 3.00pm

Class 2: 2:30pm to 2:45pm

Class 3: 2:15pm to 2:30pm

Class 4: 2:00pm to 2.15pm

Cakes will be taken through to our EYFS children by the staff for them to enjoy in their own area, as the event will perhaps be a little too busy for our youngest children. However, you can sign your EYFS child out for the afternoon to stay with you and take part in the events.

Please can I ask that children bring in small change on the Friday morning so that they have money on them to purchase cakes and take part in the competition.

The event is due to finish at 3pm, at which time you can take your own child home but they will need to be signed out before leaving school. Any children that normally walk home from school unaccompanied will be expected to remain in school until 3.15pm. Extended Provision will operate as usual.

We look forward to seeing you on the day; it will be so lovely to be able to host this event for such a worthy cause. Please come and support our school in raising money to help Macmillan to be there when it matters for their patients and families.
