Extended 3 and 4 year old offer -30 Hours Funded Place

As well as the standard 15 hours, most working parents of three and four year olds will be eligible for an additional 15 hours of childcare per week (across the school year, 38 weeks).

To be eligible:

Both parents must be in paid work (or the sole parent in a lone parent family) with each parent earning a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at national living wage, and less than £100,000 per year.

(Working includes employed, self-employed and zero contract hours who meet the above criteria)

Both parents are employed but one or both parents is temporarily away from the workplace:

on **statutory** parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave, sick pay

One parent is employed and the other parent:

- has substantial caring responsibilities based on specific benefits received for caring
- is disabled or incapacitated based on receipt of specific benefits.

You need to complete an application to confirm your eligibility. This can be done at:

If you are found eligible you will be issued with a **30 hour code** which you need to give to your childcare provider so you can access a 30 hours place. Then **every 3 months** you will need to go back **onto your childcare** account at https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/ website and **reconfirm your eligibility** as the code only last 3 months.
