01/09/1924 – Diocesan Inspection school closed in afternoon.

03/09/1924 – Newly appointed Vicar Rev. W. Bracecamp visited the school.

21/09/1924 – Sergeant Major Wright inspected the drill, physical and games.

APPLYING FOR A RECEPTION PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER 2027

If your child was born between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023, he/she is due to start reception class in September 2027. To apply for a Reception Class place for September 2027, you will need to register your family's details using the Citizen Portal and then complete an online application form. Please see on the reverse of this letter, important information regarding the online application process for Warrington residents. You are advised to refer to this information when registering and applying. The on-line facility will be available from Monday 1 September 2026 until midnight on Friday 15 January 2027. If you do not live in Warrington you need to apply through the local authority you pay your council tax to. Please visit your home local authority website for information. Wigan open their application process on 30th September 2026.

Letters have been emailed to children in our nursery who are due to start school in September 2027. We have also organised an open afternoon to meet the Headteacher and to look round our lovely school. Please book an appointment to attend one of these sessions via Mrs Holcroft in the school office.

APPLYING FOR A YEAR 7 PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER 2027

As your child was born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016, he/she is due to transfer to secondary school in September 2027.

To apply for a Year 7 place for September 2027, you will need to register your family's details using the Citizen Portal and then complete an online application form. The online facility for secondary transfer admissions will be available until **midnight on 31 October 2026**. For details on how to register and apply online, please see the information overleaf.

If you do not live in Warrington you will need to apply through the Local Authority you pay your council tax to, even if your preferences are for schools in another Local Authority. Please visit your home Local Authority's website for information on how to apply.

If your child has an Education Health and Care Plan you do not need to apply online via the Citizen Portal as you should have already been provided with information.
