- Homework There will be a weekly spelling list given out on Monday and tests will be on Friday. Please support your child in learning these words. There will also be a paper-based homework, which will support our classroom learning.

• Reading – All children are expected to read 3 times a week and have this recorded in their Reading Journal by an adult. This will be checked in the morning and stamped by the class teacher.
