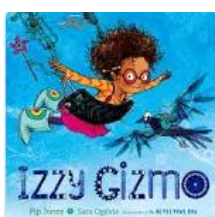

'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1910- January 10th- Re-opened the school after holidays a good attendance to commence.

1910- March 10th-Drill had to be taken within doors as a rainstorm came on.

1910-May 24th- Empire Day -suitable lessons on the "Empire" given instead of usual timetable. Holiday given in the afternoon.
