Ref: Leadership Update - December 2025

Thank you to everyone who attended the Headteacher meeting on **18th December 2025**, after school. As promised especially for those who could not attend the meeting, below is a summary of the questions raised, and the answers provided regarding leadership and school arrangements for the coming months.

Questions & Answers

Question- What date does the leadership change start and end? The change begins on Monday 5th January 2026 and will continue until July 2026.

Question- How often will you be at Glazebury? I will be physically at Glazebury approximately 20% of the time, and at the other school 80% of the time. This is flexible to meet the needs of both schools, and I will also work on shared priorities across settings to make efficiencies.

Question: With Mrs Carroll on maternity leave, who will represent Early Years in the Senior Leadership Team? Being part of the Senior Leadership Team is based on experience. We will not be changing the current model, and there is potential for broader leadership meetings across schools if needed.

Question: Who is the SENDCo now? Miss Hannah Threadgold is the designated SENDCo for Glazebury CE. We have an expanded SEND model during this time, with flexibility to ensure paperwork and statutory requirements are completed effectively.

Question: Who will be teaching Class 4? Mr Sharma will teach every morning, covering English and Maths and completing planning. A fully qualified teacher Ms J Hampson, will teach two afternoons per week (Tuesday and Wednesday) to provide additional capacity when I am offsite. She will also be teaching Class 3 one hour a week.

Question: What differences will Year 5 and 6 experience day-to-day? The only changes will be:

- Two afternoons per week taught by the newly appointed teacher (Tuesday and Wednesday).
- PE day will move to Thursday afternoons for Class 4, still with Mr Augustin.

Question: Is this arrangement permanent or temporary? It is in place until July 2026.

Question to Chair of Governors: Will this affect Governor meetings or schedules? No, all Governor meetings and communication will remain the same.

Questions from children:

Class 3/4: Question: Will Headteacher Awards still happen? Yes! When I am in school, I will continue collecting post-its for fabulous behaviour and kindness and awarding Headteacher certificates.

Class 1/2: Question: Will we still get heart stickers? Yes, heart stickers will still be given out for wonderful learning behaviours.

Class 5/6: Question: Who will do boosters? Mr Sharma and Mrs Goman will lead booster sessions, with Mrs Goman taking over English support.
