### Head Teacher's Hello



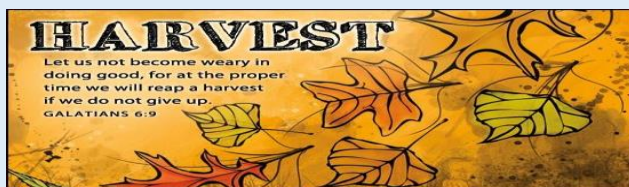
Dear all,

However, if your child normally attends Extended Provision on Monday and/or Tuesday your child will automatically be included in the curriculum clubs. Places are limited.



### First Admission to Primary School

**– September 2024** – If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020, he/she is due to start reception class in September 2024.

The application window has now opened. Letters will be sent home regarding the procedure.

### Applying for Year 7 Place for

**September 2024 Secondary School** – If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2013, he/she is due to transfer to secondary school in September 2024.

To apply for a year 7 place for September 2024, you will need to register your family's details using the Citizen Portal and then complete an online application form. Letters will be sent home with details on how to register and apply online.

The online facility for secondary transfer admissions will be available from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023 until midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023.

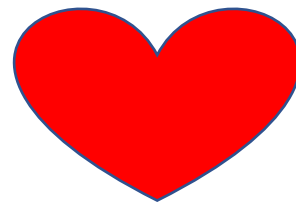
