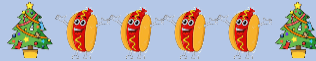

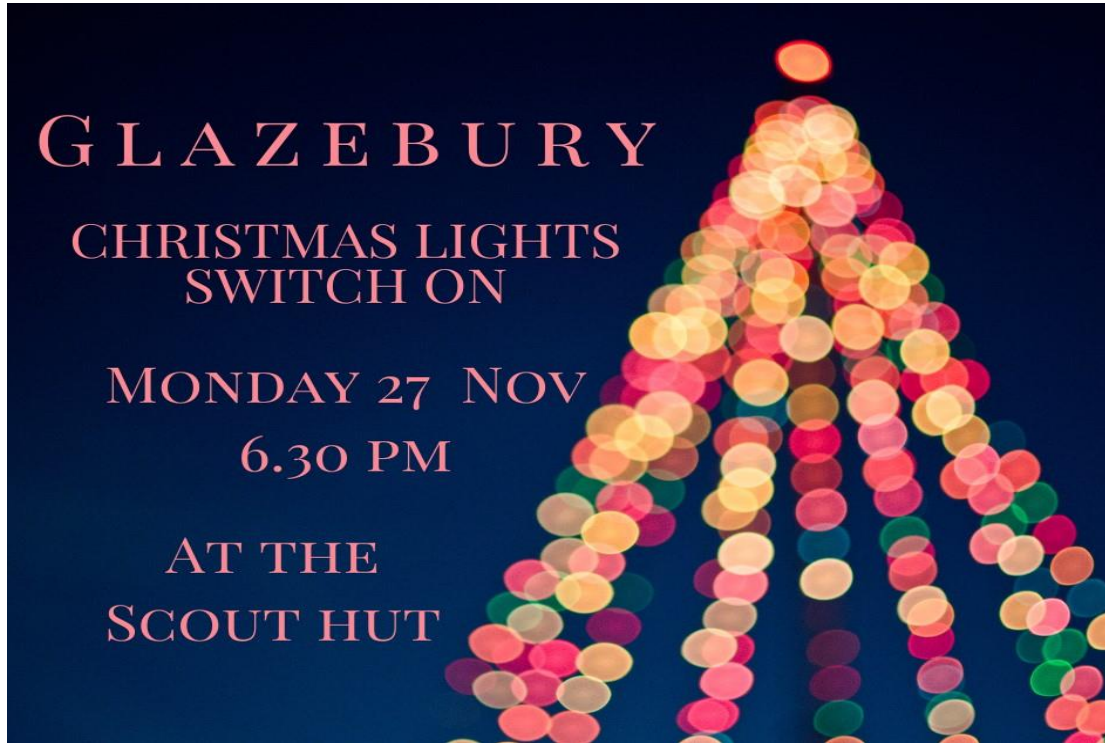
NEW SCHOOL MEAL MENU
