At our Trust Head Teachers Forum yesterday, I was pleased to find out that we are the best performing school in terms of persistent absenteeism. Recent data has found that 'persistently absent pupils could earn £10,000 less at the age of 28 compared to pupils with near-perfect attendance'. To me, that is a pretty big holiday for a 28 year-old!

'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1914-February 17th – Cases of diphtheria are appearing in the village. Two scholars -Jessie Davies and Chris Slater have developed the disease.

1914-May 8th- The vicar visited school and asked for permission to address the children on the evils of bird nesting.

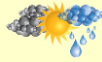


Gardening Club

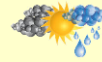
If anyone has any surplus vegetable or summer bedding plants that they will not use our Gardening Club would greatly receive your donation.

There are plenty more great events coming up to look forward to, sip and paint, family quiz night and another favourite our pop up shop, don't forget to check the dates lists.

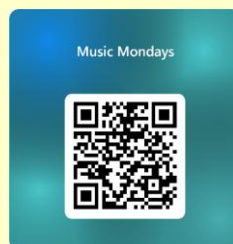
