**'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8<sup>th</sup> 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.**

1903 -9<sup>th</sup> December – Headmaster late several times this week on account of illness of Mrs Holden.

1904 -11<sup>th</sup> January – Slates are discarded altogether and have not been used since November of last year. Pen and paper are used instead.

1904 -14<sup>th</sup> March – New casters arrived for the piano.

1904 -25<sup>th</sup> March – Warned boys about trespassing in the fields and birds nesting.

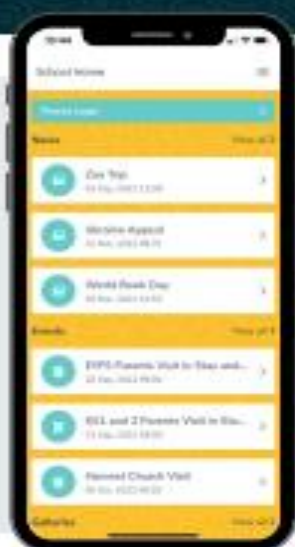
