Dear Parents and Carers

In conjunction with our School Council, we would like to share with you our plans for the positive behaviour system this Spring Term 2019. As a school we reward good behaviour as it develops an ethos of kindness and co-operation. If a child gains 10 Class Dojo's over the week they will receive a golden ticket, which they collect and earn rewards.

In Spring Term we are setting the target of **5 Golden Tickets** and are linking our reward to World Book Day on Thursday 7th March 2019. **All** children on World Book are invited to come into school in their pyjamas for the day, as part of our 'snuggle up with a book'. A programme of events will be planned for all children to promote a love of reading. However, the School Council will help organise an additional breakfast treat event for all pupils who have received 5 Golden Tickets by this date. All pupils across the school had an opportunity to vote for a reward idea and the winner was pyjamas and breakfast!

The School Council have decided that to make sure children have an incentive to keep collecting golden tickets after they have reached their 5 in Spring, there will be a year group champion announced on the penultimate Friday of each full term. This champion will have collected the most golden tickets that term out of their year group. They will have their photograph taken for our behaviour display, be allowed to come into school in their own clothes on the date agreed and have a special treat with Mrs Mowbray! There will be 8 champions in each term.

In addition, the children have agreed that in the summer term they will work as a whole school to earn a set amount of golden tickets together to earn a whole school event day, rather than individually as in the other two terms.
