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Dear Parents, and Carers

Ref: schools reopening for Monday 22nd June 2020

As previously communicated, I can confirm that our LDST directors have confirmed that after meeting with health representatives that school can continue to open for all confirmed eligible children on the 22.6.20. This coincides with Warrington Local authority approach:

The council's Director of Public Health, Eileen O'Meara, said: "I am confident that a phased return of pupils back to school can be safely managed.

"Where head teachers and councils in the region have rightly paused to consider if they should expand the number of children coming back to school, including Warrington, I support the decision locally to now proceed with a phased return. This includes our secondary year 10 and 12 groups.

"Evidence from the North West Scientific and Advisory cell (STAC), demonstrates that there is very low transmission from child to child and children to adults in schools. I am also assured that plans are in place to manage any suspected cases of COVID-19 in schools, with each school having prepared robust risk assessments alongside the council. There will be strict adherence to the health and safety arrangements made in each school, alongside containment arrangements such as 'bubbles' of staff working together.

"Everyone has a role to play in keeping schools safe and I would like to make clear that the public should continue to observe social distancing, use face coverings where social distancing isn't possible and continue good hygiene practices."

Aspects to remind confirmed eligible year groups (Key workers, Nursery, Year 1 and Year 6)

I would like to share with parents and reassure those returning to school as part of the Phase 2 easing of lock down, but I must point out that **these plans may be subject to change**.

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Under current government guidelines the classrooms have been confirmed as having the following capacity:

As you can imagine this has restricted our intentions to fully open to the eligible year groups:

Key/Critical workers, Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. Thank you to all the parents who were so honest with us about your intention to return, and this has helped us to plan, although we may not be able to please everyone, we have worked tirelessly to provide the safe environment for children to return to school.

What we have put into place: From the numbers collated, we will have 6 "family bubbles" with at least 2 members of staff that will remain within that bubble, the children and staff will not be able to mix with other bubbles in school to ensure safety for all.
