IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION OF CHANGES Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

Warrington Borough Council have advised of important changes to **Free School Meals (FSM)** and **Pupil Premium (PP)** from **September 2026**. Below gives you a simple overview of what is changing and what you need to do.

What is changing:

For 2026/27 academic year, all children attending a maintained school, academy or free school will qualify for FSM if their family receives Universal Credit.

New FSM categories:

There will now be two types of FSM:

Targeted FSM

For pupils whose families receive Universal Credit and earn £7,400 or less per year

Expanded FSM

For pupils whose families receive Universal Credit and earn above £7,400 per year

Important: Only pupils eligible for Targeted FSM will receive PP funding from September 2026

Please apply without delay to check your eligibility

In the first instance you can visit www.warrington.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals and download / complete the application form.

Free School Meals

Important Update

From September 2026

National eligibility criteria for Free School Meals (FSM) is expanding.

New rules

All households receiving Universal Credit will now qualify.

Current £7,400 income threshold removed.

How This Helps You

Families could **save up to £495 per child**, per year on school meal costs*.

What You Need To Do

If you receive Universal Credit, you should **apply for Free School Meals before 30 September 2026**.

Children are being allocated a Country to represent, and your child will be informed today what to wear. I.e: Red/ Blue / White or Yellow – t-shirt or shorts or socks (whatever clothing item they have).

If your nursery child doesn't usually attend on a Thursday morning and you would like them to, please let the nursery lead or school office know. You can bring them along at 9am on Thursday, they can remain with yourself and then take part in their event. Children in school will remain with their class throughout the event for safety and organisation.

All events will take place on the school field. We kindly ask that you enter the school via the main pedestrian entrance on Hurst Lane.

To help ensure a smooth and enjoyable day, please ensure your child:

- Brings a **water bottle**
- Wears a **hat**
- Has their PE kit and trainers in school.
- Has **sun cream applied** before arriving at school (weather dependent)

A refreshment station will be provided for each year group to help children stay hydrated. Drinks will be provided for children.

Refreshments will also be available for parents and carers to purchase, and we encourage you to bring a **chair or blanket** for comfort while watching the events.

In the event of poor weather, we will send a text message update by **8:30am** on the day.

Please ensure you have let the office know your wrap around – breakfast and extended provision requirement for September 26. We can then confirm place allocation as we need to ensure staffing and ratios are in place by **Friday 10th July latest**.
