


Head Teacher's Hello

Education update: where we inform on educational research and thinking.

What is an Exit task? At the end of a unit of work, children are asked to answer the central question they have been answering in their learning e.g. What did the Romans ever do for us? They do this by writing an "Essay" Year 1 and 2 would complete 2-5 sentences, year 3 and 4 would complete 1-2 paragraph and year 5 and 6 would complete 3-5 paragraphs all to show their learning...impressive.
