3	Identify and explain the errors then write the correct answers.	a. LXII is one less than LXIII, not one more. LXIV b. XLII is 20 less than LXIII. The 'X' has been moved, not removed. LIII c. LXIIII is not an accurate way of writing 64. LXIV d. LXVVV is again an inaccurate way to write 75. LXXV e. This shows an understanding of XL being 10 less than 40. This also shows that the pupil does not know how to write 90. They have attempted to use 50 + 40 to write 90 instead of 100 - 10. XCV f. The answer shows 100 + 10 + 10 + 1 instead of 100 - 10 -1 + 10. XCIX
