




Learn, Love and Achieve with Jesus ...

'Peep into Glazebury's History from Log Books - We are in possession of our school log books that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.



23 July 1880- Many of the children have been absent during the week helping with the hay. Dec 19 – Mary Wilkinson, Ellen Green, Ellen Mort have been away with whooping cough.

Feb 4th 1881 -Rev G. Feather visited the school.

July 20th 1881- admitted the half timers from Glazebury No.1 school and had to get 2 new registers.


