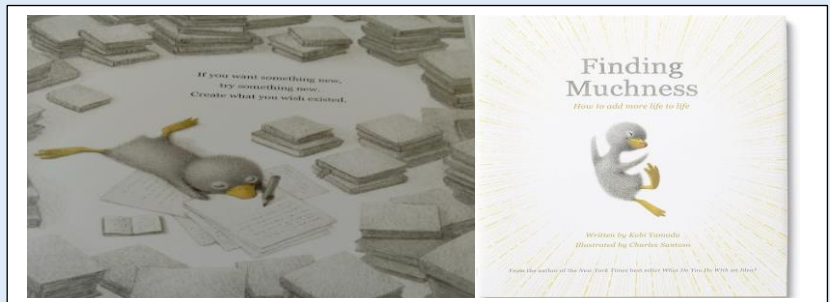

**'Peep into Glazebury's History from Log Books - We are in possession of our school log books that date back to July 8<sup>th</sup> 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.**



23 July 1880- Many of the children have been absent during the week helping with the hay.  
Dec 19 – Mary Wilkinson, Ellen Green, Ellen Mort have been away with whooping cough.

Feb 4<sup>th</sup> 1881 -Rev G. Feather visited the school.

July 20<sup>th</sup> 1881- admitted the half timers from Glazebury No.1 school and had to get 2 new registers.
