

'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July  $8^{\rm th}$  1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1909- August 21<sup>st</sup> – a very wet afternoon, had to light the fires to dry the children's clothes.

1909-November 18<sup>th</sup> -school visited by Sergeant Major Wright for the purpose of inspecting the drill.

1909-November 24<sup>th</sup> -The school yard was very soft consequently four boys were sent with wheelbarrows for cinders to make the door approaches drier.

A winner will be chosen for the most amazing creation and the winner will receive a Christmas prize.








