Key Bible Passages:

Matthew 14:29-31: Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came towards Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, 'Lord, save me!' Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. 'You of little faith,' he said, 'why did you doubt?'

Acts 2:44-47: 'All the believers were together and had everything in common. They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. Every day they continued to meet together... They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God.'

Colossians 3:8-9: But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices.'

Mohandras Karamchand Gandhi

(2.10.1869 - 30.1.1948)

Born in Porbander in Gujarat, India.

Brought up in a Hindu home.

Started 'The National Indian Congress'; Non-violent political protests.

1916, horrified to see oppression of the Indian people of Bihar by white British masters.

Encouraged peaceful protests and strikes against unfair treatment of Indian people by the British.

A voice for freedom and fairness; Became known as 'Mahatma', meaning 'Great Soul'.

1922 and then again when WW2 broke out: imprisoned for 2 years each time. 1930: The Salt March.

His protests made a difference. Assassinated in 1948.
