

'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

3rd July 1903 – Closed school for Mill holidays

17th July 1903 - A heavy thunderstorm caused a very poor attendance. The playground was flooded for several hours.

5th November 1903 – school floor dirty this morning not properly swept.

11th November ~1903-Fred Warhurst is suffering from measles. Have sent three of the family home this morning.

Is my child too ill for school?


