


#### Dear all,

'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8<sup>th</sup> 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1909-March 2<sup>nd</sup> – A very wintery morning. Heavy fall of snow. Attendance dropped by over 30, the severe weather and sickness (colds) has caused the worst weekly average in over four years.

1909-August 3<sup>rd</sup> – Miss Elizabeth Ann Wood, age 17 commenced duties here as Student Teacher.

To apply for a Reception Class place for September 2026, you will need to register your family's details using the Citizen Portal and then complete an online application form.

The on-line facility will be available from Monday 1 September 2025 until midnight on Thursday 15 January 2026.

# TRANSFER TO SECONDARY SCHOOL - SEPTEMBER

The online application form will be available for parents/carers to apply from 1 September 2025 until midnight on 31 October 2025.

Half term - School Holidays




We break up today at the usual time. We hope you all have a safe and enjoyable half term holiday and look forward to welcoming you back on Monday 3rd November.










#### **ATTENDANCE**
