'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1914- August 5th – Mr W.N Anderton, newly appointed teacher has been called away to join the territorial army for garrison duty. Consequently, the school is again short of staff.

1914-A few children (half timers) are away picking potatoes in the field. Some younger children 9 or 10 years of age have also been kept at home for this purpose.

- Options to buy additional top up sessions as required



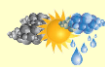

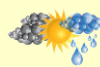

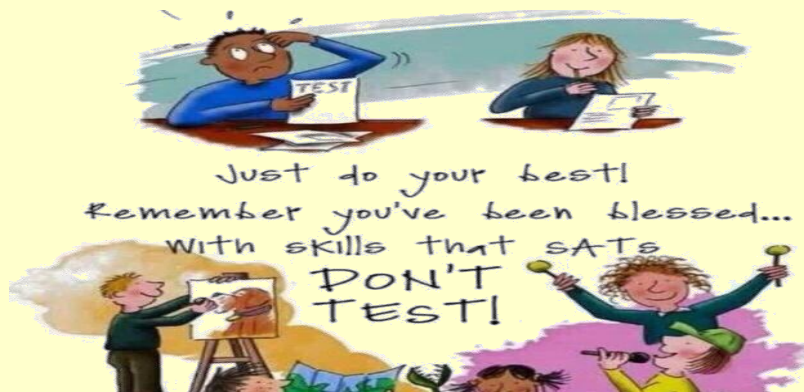
Outside Classroom

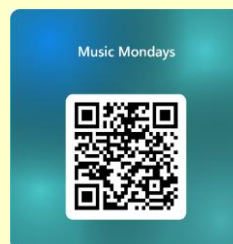

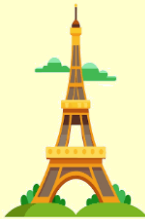
