**1909-May 14<sup>th</sup> – warned children about trespassing and bird nesting.**

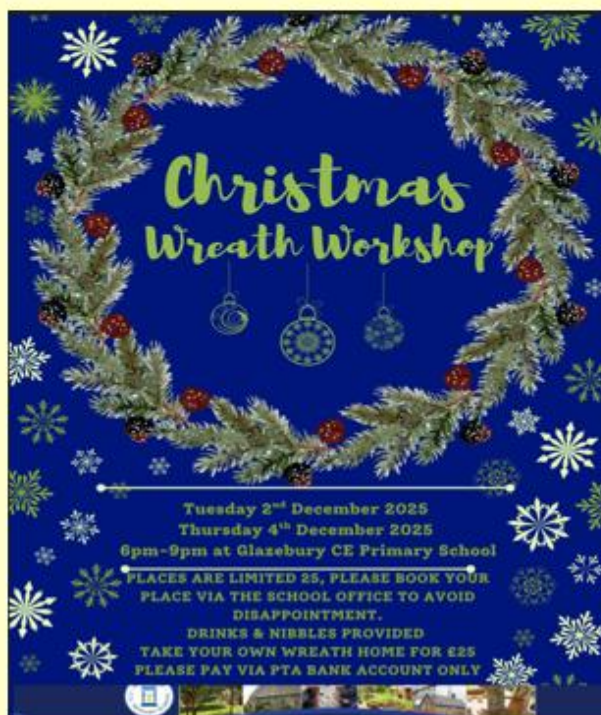
