




### Parental survey for Remote learners - January 2021.


#### Responses:

1. How would you rate the quality of instruction that your child receives for remote learning through Class Dojo (Activities, messages, timetables...)?





2. How would you rate the quality of the resources school utilises for remote learning, for example Times Table Rockstars, White Rose maths videos, Spelling Shed...?




**81.25% of responses answered very good or excellent.** We will regularly refine and always look to enhance our offer, for example, staff recording class stories for remote learning.

3. How confident does your child feel in contacting their class teacher/ school through Class Dojo messaging system? (Including portfolio)





4. Currently, how would you rate your child's emotional wellbeing during this lockdown?





5. As a parent/carer, how would you rate communication from school regarding information associated with remote learning? (Texts, e-mails, Letters, Class Dojo)





6. How useful do you find the paper-based resources school delivers for remote learning?





7. How do you feel the support from school has been for you and your family during this lockdown?




**87.5% of responses answered very good or excellent.** Please do communicate with school if you have any ideas of how we can support further, we will always try to do our best to listen and help.
