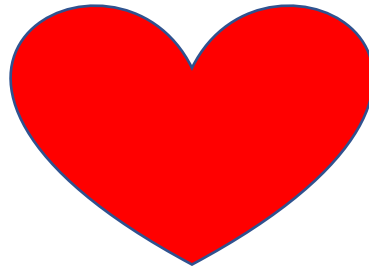
ATTENDANCE
