IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION OF CHANGES Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

Warrington Borough Council have advised of important changes to **Free School Meals (FSM)** and **Pupil Premium (PP)** from **September 2026**. Below gives you a simple overview of what is changing and what you need to do.

What is changing:

For 2026/27 academic year, all children attending a maintained school, academy or free school will qualify for FSM if their family receives Universal Credit.

New FSM categories:

There will now be two types of FSM:

Targeted FSM

For pupils whose families receive Universal Credit and earn £7,400 or less per year

Expanded FSM

For pupils whose families receive Universal Credit and earn above £7,400 per year

Important: Only pupils eligible for Targeted FSM will receive PP funding from September 2026

What happens next

The new checking system was expected to be available from beginning of June, and all families will need to apply this half term. We are still waiting for this information, WBC have advised there will be an online checking system available next week (w/c 22/6) and we will notify you via School Spider when it is live and you will be able to check.

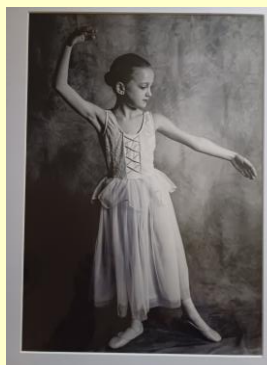


Well done Alex from Year 4 who played his first cricket match playing for Bury Cricket Club.
