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Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to a new school year at Glazebury. We would like to take this opportunity to share our current practise regarding behaviour and rewards and share updates with you.

Feedback on Class Dojo has been highly positive, particularly during last year's unprecedented year, so we will continue to use Class Dojo for communication for staff, parents and children. We believe the key to promoting good behaviour is to ensure high expectations which are applied consistently and fairly throughout the school.

As a school we ensure we reward good behaviour as it develops an ethos of kindness and co-operation. Our approach is designed to promote good behaviour, rather than merely deter antisocial behaviour. However, the school employs a number of consistent sanctions to uphold the school rules, and to ensure a safe and positive learning environment for all. Below is a simplified copy of what is displayed around school and supported by Class dojo.

<i>All children start each day on green. Fantastic behaviour being shown</i>	Green	Ready to learn
<i>Reminded of Golden Rules. When behaviour is modified, child highly praised and name goes back to green.</i>	Amber	Low level incidents- for example shouting out, chatting, nudging, distracting others.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• When behaviour is modified, child highly praised. Child to acknowledge the improvement of own behaviour by apologising. Name is moved back to amber then eventually green.• 5 minutes play lost• Teacher completes a low-level incident form.	Red	Persistent repetition of amber behaviour Or immediately if... Used inappropriate language or purposely hurt others.

We will ensure parents are aware if a child has received a red during the day through class dojo and be able to support next steps.



The main points about our behaviour system include;

- Each child will be moved up or down the behaviour system as required and this information will be shared, when appropriate, through Class Dojo.
- All children will start each day on green, so have a fresh start.
- If a child gains 10 Class Dojo's over the week they will receive a sticker (on Thursday) and their name will go in the school newsletter. A central record will be kept of children who have reached 10 dojo's each week. (rewards below)
- The behaviour system will run Thursday- Thursday to allow for celebration in both our newsletter and celebration worship. Dojo's will be re-set each Friday.
- From the central records rewards will be planned as follows:

10 golden tickets in Autumn	Mrs. Mowbray's High Tea
8 golden tickets in Spring	TBC by School Council
Whole school target to be set by School Council in Summer	Summer Celebration Day

Each event is isolated to a term and after the term is complete all children will start back on 0.

Children voice:

The School Council representatives decided that to make sure children have an incentive to keep collecting golden tickets after they have reached their 10 in Autumn, there will be a year group champion announced on the penultimate Friday of the term. This champion will have collected the most golden tickets that term out of their year group. They will have their photograph taken for our behaviour display in school, be allowed to come into school in their own clothes on the date agreed and have a special breakfast to start their day with Mrs Mowbray! There will be eight champions in each term.

Everyone within our school community has rights and responsibilities to ensure that Glazebury C of E Primary School is a safe place in which to learn, work and play.
