'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8<sup>th</sup> 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1912- Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>- Owing to darkness and rain children were sent home 10 minutes early.

1913-Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>-Wet day, had to get a boy to light fires to dry wet clothes, after chopping the wood myself. The caretaker is working in the factory and is never at hand during school hours.








# Let's Celebrate You!
