Head Teacher's Hello

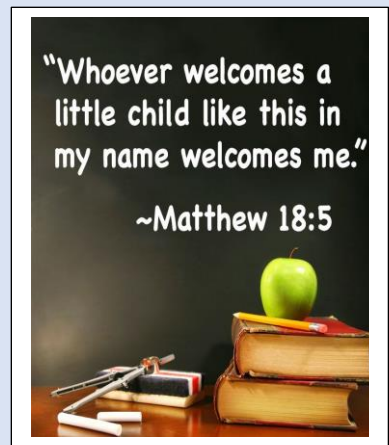

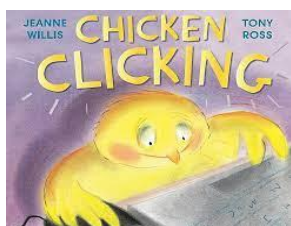
Great news...we are welcoming our New incumbent at the end of September: Reverend Bob Lewis, I am sure he will be very welcome at our school and in our community.

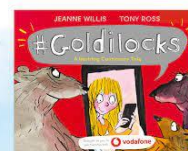
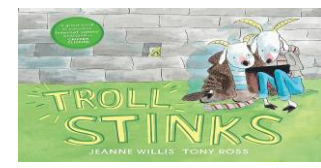

Applying for Year 7 Place for September 2024 Secondary School – If

your child was born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2013, he/she is due to transfer to secondary school in September 2024.

To apply for a year 7 place for September 2024, you will need to register your family's details using the Citizen Portal and then complete an online application form. Letters will be sent home with details on how to register and apply online.

The online facility for secondary transfer admissions will be available from 1st September 2023 until midnight on 31st October 2023.



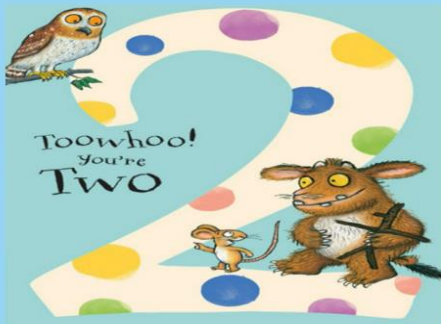

- Options available to buy additional top up sessions as required.

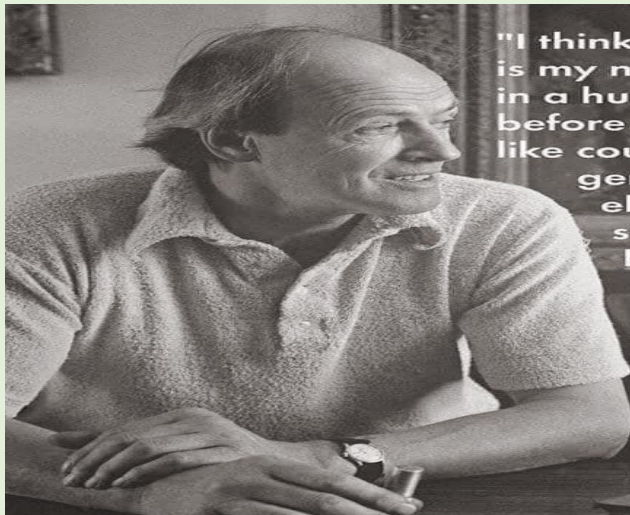
