Dear Parents, and Carers,

Ref: School reopening for Thursday 2nd September 2021

We are hoping and praying for a much more consistent year this coming academic year, with a view to a more 'normal' school year. As a result of new guidance I have amended information to parents, this is also on our website

As you are aware, schools must comply with strict health and safety guidelines set by health and safety law and set by the government. Underpinning all decisions have been a focus on a 'system of controls', which build on the hierarchy of protective measures in place currently, please can we remind you that for the safety of all these must still be implemented as indicated below:

Prevention:

- > Minimise contact with those who are unwell
- > Clean hands thoroughly more often than usual
- > Practice good respiratory hygiene "catch it, bin it"
- > Enhanced cleaning
- > Minimise contact between individuals wherever possible
- > Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when required

Response:

> Manage confirmed cases of COVID-19 amongst the school community

How will we get into school?

Entrance and exit to school: Please see below for allocated time and entrance. In Reception and Nursery, a member of staff will come into the playground to welcome children, at these stipulated times, when the whistle blows children will line up in their class groups.

Please note you can now access the playgrounds from any entrance point.

Children are NOT allowed in the playground unaccompanied.

VISITORS/Parents: Will still be required to wear face masks when entering the school building. This will be reviewed at the end of Autumn 1 2021.

Frequently asked questions...

Office: If you need to speak to anyone in the office, please be aware that staff will also continue to speak from behind the glass partition. Where possible phone or email the office.

Breaks: If you are providing your own snack it must be in a healthy snack.(No Nuts)

Lunches will be managed in class groups in our dining hall, if you are choosing to have a packed lunch this may now be brought in a lunchbox. Children's individual water bottles are provided and cleaned by the school.

Breakfast club : This is available from 7.30 am at the start of school day, **to access this provision of this** you need to have booked a place, there will be no adhoc places available. Entrance will be from the Office area (main entrance) Extended Provision (EYFS-Y2) form 3.15pm to access this provision of this you need to have booked a place, there will be no adhoc places available. Collection will be from the Reception class entrance as usual.

Curriculum clubs: These will be available to all children as previous practice, booking places will be via the school office. **Collection points at the end of clubs will be from the Key stage one playground – doors into the hall.**

Uniform: ALL children must be in full school uniform as in September (see website), we expect all children to have the appropriate footwear, and PE kit (which is to be in a **small** bag on MONDAY and left in school until FRIDAY)

<u>NO large bags</u> are to be brought into school, We do not have the internal space in school .

Attendance: A reminder that attendance is **mandatory** as per government guidelines and penalties and processes for non-attendance are in force across the authority.

Engaging with the NHS Test and Trace Process:

If you or your child display - A high temperature

- A new and continuous cough

- Loss or change to sense of taste or smell

If you develop these symptoms, however mild, at any point Stay at home from the day your symptoms develop and at least the next 10 full days as advised in: https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stay-at-home-guidance/stay-athome-guidance-

And book a free test at www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test or by calling 119. At this point, all other household members (even if they remain well) must stay at home and not leave the house for 10 days. The 10-day period starts from the day when the first person in the house became ill. Household members should not go to work, school, or public areas

Follow PHE advise and notify school on <u>glazeburyprimary.head@ldst.org.uk</u> to confirm test results.

* If POSITIVE -Provide details of anyone you have been in close contact with if asked to by NHS -**Track and Trace** service

* If negative and you are feeling well, you can then attend school
