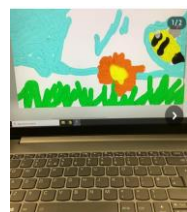

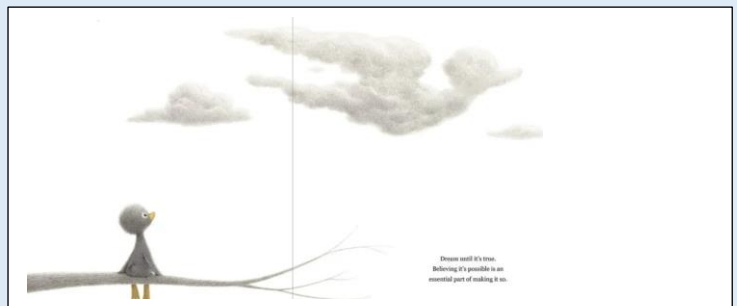

'Peep into Glazebury's History from Log Books - We are in possession of our school log books that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.



1881-12th December Diocesan Report

This school, now the only school in the parish, has largely increased in numbers during the year . The children will in a short time be taught in a new and commodious building, now being erected close to the church.

20th November 1882

Glazebury National School

The school met for the first time this morning in the new school building
The number of children present 160.

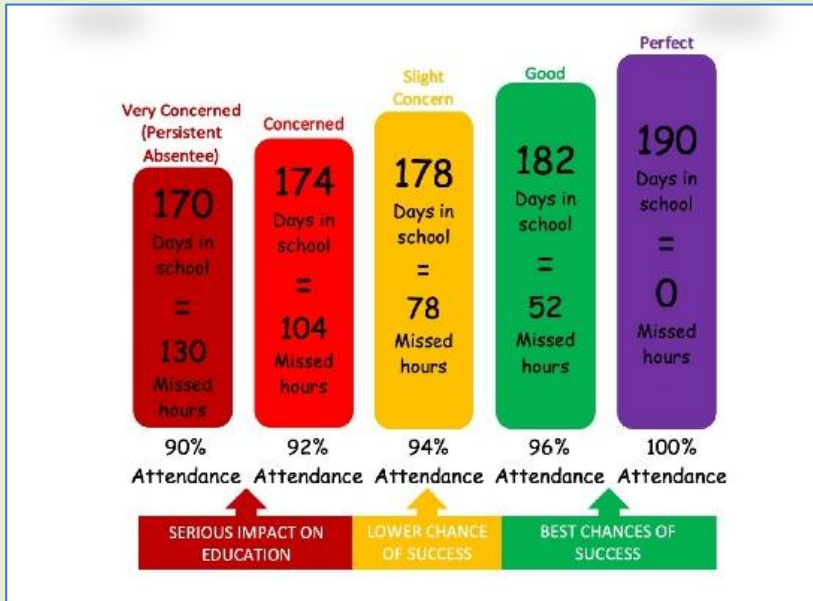
