Set up automated balance alerts from your ParentPay account which will alert you by email and/or SMS text message when your balances reach a threshold that you provide. Please follow the set up:

- Login to your ParentPay Account
- Select the Communication Tab (at the top of the screen)
- Scroll down to the Balance Alerts section
- Add a threshold amount against your chose item i.e. School Lunch
- Tick email and/or text alert (your chosen alert method)
- Scroll down to the bottom
- Click on Save.


