Education update: where we inform on educational research and thinking.

What are retention/retrieval quizzes? At our school when we teach a lesson in our foundations subjects (RE, History, Geography, Art and DT, etc) we then assess through 2 or 3 key questions at the end. In the next lesson we build on that knowledge and again assess with an extra 2 or 3 questions – so at the end of the unit of work the consistent questions built up help learning to be retained.
