Parent Teacher Association Meeting September 16th 2019

Opening Statements

Chair (Donna-Marie) welcomed everyone to the first meeting of the school year and passed on apologies from Liz Dodd and Louise Blinkhorn.

Treasurer (Anna) updated the group on the financial position. Following all income and expenditures from the 2018-19 financial/school year the PTA has just over £80 in the bank to start the 2019-20 financial/school year.

The AGM was briefly discussed and scheduled for the next meeting – on Monday October 14th from 6pm.

PTA Fundraising Goal for 2019-20

School Representative and Headteacher Karen Mowbray presented to the group the proposal that the PTA goal for the 2019-20 year be to part-fund the school's intended purchase of a minibus and booster seats for those smaller/younger children. The proposed benefits of the school minibus being support to the local community e.g. the church and other local schools, transport to year 3 swimming lessons and transport to competitions.

The ongoing costs of the minibus were discussed (maintenance, insurance etc.) and were agreed not to require an ongoing feed of funds from the PTA.

There was some discussion also that this was a larger goal than previously aimed for and as the final costs were as yet unknown it was not possible to put a figure on the PTA contribution at this time. A visual representation of this type of larger goal was also discussed (e.g. a thermometer or similar) to give parents a view of the progress toward the goal and maintain momentum through the year.

There is to be a bid for lottery funding toward the minibus (with the assistance of a bid-writer being paid for from school funds) which, if successful, would free up PTA funds to be diverted to other initiatives – may look into last year's parent suggestions of more music in school and a shelter for pick-up and drop-off times.

Courageous Advocacy

School Representative and Headteacher Karen Mowbray also raised the school's aim to provide Courageous Advocacy in the local community and the following upcoming charity events:
