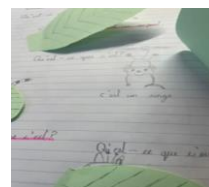

'Peep into Glazebury' s History from Log Books -We are in possession of our school log books that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.



15th Sept 1873 – small attendance – very wet weather.

3rd Feb 1874-admitted Mary Ratcliffe.

6th March 1874- reproved James Dean and Annie Newstow for coming late, kept them in school a quarter of an hour after the other scholars.
