Dear all,

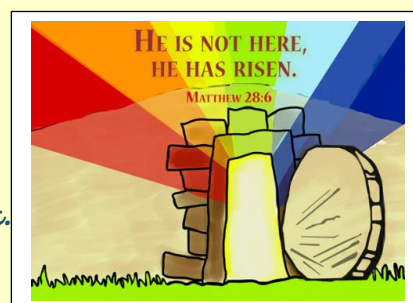
What a lovely event we held last Friday for mums, grandmas and carers, thank you Mrs Carroll for organising tea and cakes and activities that were loved by all.

'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8th 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1906- 16th November – another wet day, school playground flooded.

1907-24th January -warned children against risks of sliding on ponds covered with Ice.

1907-25th January – punished several children for sliding on adjacent pond after having been forbidden.

Clubs welcome pupils in Year 2—Year 6. The cost of each club is £3.50 per week. Payment is via ParentPay.

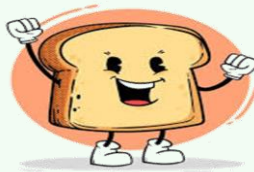
If your child is already booked into Extended Club, they will automatically attend the clubs.

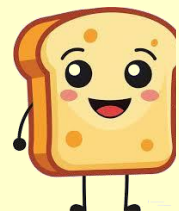
Toast - Healthy Snack
