'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8<sup>th</sup> 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.

1906- 16<sup>th</sup> November – another wet day, school playground flooded.

1907-24<sup>th</sup> January -warned children against risks of sliding on ponds covered with Ice.

1907-25<sup>th</sup> January – punished several children for sliding on adjacent pond after having been forbidden.
