As a school we are all looking at how we can be Peace makers and using our Christian value passports for inspiration.



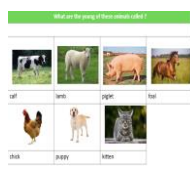

The School-Aged Immunisation Team deliver the routine national immunisation programme to school-aged children (reception - year 11) within Warrington.

The team is made up of professionals who are highly skilled and experienced in giving vaccinations.

### WHO CAN ATTEND COMMUNITY CLINICS?

- Children who have missed their vaccination in school
- Children who are home educated
- Children who want their parent to be present when they have their vaccination
- Children who need to have the flu injection rather than the flu nasal spray

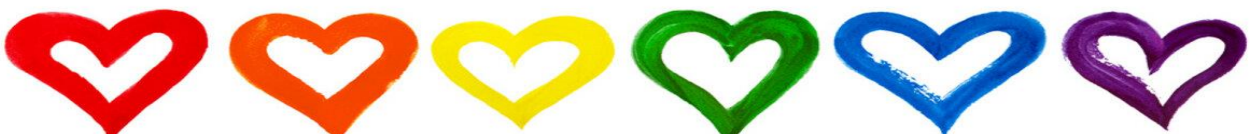

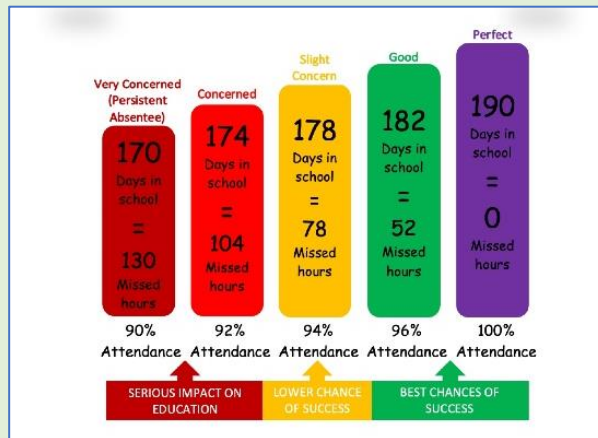
