<p>Children will stay in Class bubbles (groups) which <b>WILL NOT</b> interact with other bubbles where possible.</p> 	<p>School hours are staggered by 5 minutes to ensure everyone can enter and leave the school safely. Learning time is now a statutory expectations</p> 	<p>Parents are required to have all children attend school. Government penalties are now in place.</p>  <p><b>During Tier 2 and 3 face coverings will be required on school grounds.</b></p>
<p>Children will be dropped off and collected from different points across the school.</p>  <p><b>It is very important that you are on time.</b> Please ring the office if you may be late.</p>	<p>Social distancing will be in place where possible, however this cannot be guaranteed <u>within</u> our school class bubbles.</p> 	<p>We will continue to provide home-learning to your children if self isolating or awaiting a test. <p>Children will be <b>regularly reminded</b> on how to wash their hands effectively and there will be frequent handwashing. All children must wash their hands with soap and water. No exceptions will be made.</p> 	<p><b>Breakfast club is open for all year groups : 7.30 to 8.50am</b>  <u>Extended Provision</u> is open for EYFS and Year 1. <b>This MUST be Pre-booked half termly via the Office and paid in advance directly into Lloyds Bank account.</b></p>	<p><u>Attending school:</u> You must inform the school if you do not plan to come to school. If packed lunch please <b>provide in a disposable bag.</b></p> 	<p> Toast will be available for children and 'live' on Parent pay (£9.25 for half term)</p>  <p><b>Please make us aware of ANY allergies especially hand sanitiser and or hand soap. Thank you.</b></p>	<p>If you have a long journey on public transport, we would encourage you to follow guidance re: Face coverings. Children will be asked to put into bags during the day ( DFE guidelines)</p> 
<p>In Reception, KS1 and KS2, children will have their own equipment.</p> 	<p>Children do not need bags in school – please do not bring in.</p>  <p>Children will have their own water bottle in school This will be for their sole use and named it will be cleaned thoroughly every day. No other is needed including at lunch time- we need disposable drinks – children will always be provided with water at dinner</p>	<p>If a child in your child's bubble (group) has symptoms, every child/teacher in the bubble will be asked to self-isolate for 10 days. <u>If test proves positive.</u> Any signs of symptoms <b>must</b> be reported to school.</p> 
<p>Toilets will be assigned to bubbles.</p> 	<p><b>Please note:</b> Uniform is required and PE kit to be in on Monday and sent home friday. We are using outside spaces as much as possible. <b>Coats are needed at all times.</b></p>
