Dear Parents and Carers

Strike action -5th July and 7th July, 2023

We are again writing out to update yourselves regarding the current teaching unions dispute with the Government. One union, the NEU, now has a legal mandate for industrial action, which will affect schools in our area on:

- Wednesday 5th JULY 2023
- Friday 7th July, 2023.

The LDST respects the rights of employees to strike and the role of Trade Unions in accordance with the legislation and balloting rules. Our Trust recognises that staff feel a very strong sense of professional imperative to take action alongside their colleagues nationally, and also a very strong sense of moral imperative to ensure that our children don't miss out. Deciding to take industrial action is never an easy decision for anyone.

At Glazebury CE Primary school we have a number of teachers in the union who will be exercising their right to strike, and as a result, our school will be:

- Partially open: 5th July 2023
 - we will be closed to pupils in Year 1/Year 2, Year 3/Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 on Wednesday 5th July, 2023
 - – Nursery, and Reception will be in school.
- Partially open: 7 July 2023
 - we will be closed to pupils in Reception, Year 1/Year 2, Year 5 and Year 6 on Friday 7th July, 2023
 - – Nursery, and Year 3/Year 4 will be in school.

This is as a result of the limited numbers of staff either in the NEU or taking strike action. Please note that this is the position as we know it now, and things can change at any time. Therefore, if there are any changes to these plans, we will let you know as soon as we can. All

avenues and adherence to guidelines and Health and Safety risk assessments have taken place. I will also prepare a pack of general learning for each child not in school to support.

We continue to be very grateful to all staff in our school for going beyond what is required of them in law, by telling us their plans so that we can plan ahead. Whilst we attempt to navigate the challenges ahead, may I thank you for your support and your appreciation of our staff who always give so much to our school, children and families.
