**'Peep into Glazebury History from Logbooks - We are in possession of our school logbooks that date back to July 8<sup>th</sup> 1873, before we were even in our school building in 1882. We thought we would share some of the accounts with you each week.**

1903-April 9<sup>th</sup> -School closed until Monday April 20<sup>th</sup> on account of Easter and building operations in the school.

1903-April 20<sup>th</sup> - Reopened school and admitted 10 new children owing to building operations, most of the oral lessons will be suspended for a few weeks.

1903-April 24<sup>th</sup>- Had occasion to warn children about climbing on and over school walls.

1903-May 7<sup>th</sup> - Punished Harold Whittle severely for playing truant and telling lies.

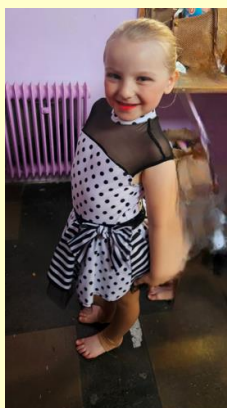
### Friday - Ice Pops

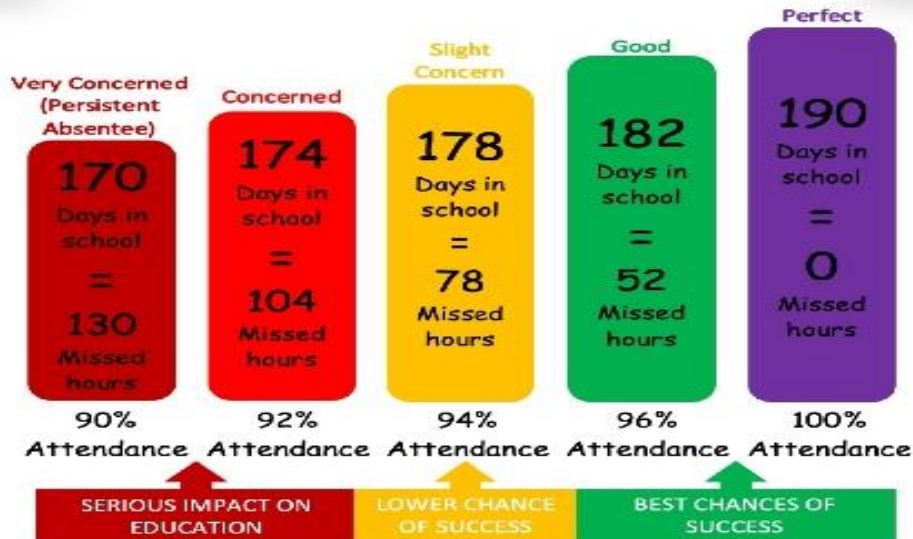


## ATTENDANCE
